Steeprock First Aid and Security Services provide industrial ambulance services for Industry as required in Northeastern British Columbia and Northwest Alberta.

Steeprock is able to provide the following services for industry to choose from:

Mobile Medical Unit (MMU) is available to provide Industry with a centrally located mobile team including qualified paramedic(s) if required and are available and dispatched to sites where Occupational First Aid Attendants/Security Team specialists require assistance. The paramedics will continue treatment and transport the patient to the closest medical facility as directed by dispatch. This service offers the Oil and Gas Industry a higher level of care in remote areas and ensures patients receive the best possible pre-hospital care available. Within the MMU team Steeprock will provide up to and including the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-A), off road driving certification, Medical Director, and proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

On-site Security and First Aid Services – This service is available to Industry working in locations that are remote. 24-hour security and on site medical services can be provided if required. The Occupational Level First Aid (Level 3) on these sites will dispatch the Mobile Medical Unit if necessary to treat, package and transport patients as necessary to the closest medical facility as directed by dispatch.

On arrival at the scene, the MMU team will determine the extent of aid that has been administered and the requirements for ongoing patient care. The MMU will also obtain necessary forms and Patient Assessment Charts from the OFA.

Once the patient has been properly prepared for transport and loaded into the mobile unit, the MMU team will depart for the nearest hospital. Safety and careful transport of the patient is a primary focus of the MMU team.

The MMU team will keep dispatch informed on patient status and the patient's estimated time of arrival to the hospital emergency. The dispatch office will be able to contact the hospital to alert them of the MMU team's arrival. On arrival, the MMU will provide patient assessment charts and will brief staff regarding the status of the patient's injuries.

Companies can be assured that Steeprock can provide quality services to take the patient from an accident site to the hospital.



Steeprock First Aid expanded its services to include security through recognizing the need for more advanced medical, safety, and security services at well-sites throughout northeast British Columbia and northwest Alberta. [Bill C-45](#) has created the need for a more inclusive service that is presently being provided by first aid service companies in the industry. This increased focus on health and safety at remote job sites reflects the need for a fulfillment of health and safety standards, Industry practices, and new Health and Safety Regulations. Steeprock First Aid has all of the documentation required to implement a safety program to ensure due diligence on the worksite.

Steeprock First Aid has qualified OFA Level 3 and BST 1 & 2 certified staff experienced in following the safety programs of the major stakeholders in the industry.

Safety and Security Coordinators

A Safety & Security Coordinator is the key to implementing on site safety standards (*IRP 7 - Standards for Well-site Supervision of Drilling Completions & Workovers, and IRP 9 - Basic Safety Program*) while meeting provincial first aid regulations.

Steeprock has qualified **On-Site Safety & Security Coordinators** who are qualified in:

- Industrial First Aid
- Well-site security - BST 1 & 2
- Emergency Response courses through ENFORM

On-Site Safety & Security Coordinator duties include:

- Provide medical services
- Implement on-site safety standards
 - Ensure all people entering jobsite have protective equipment
 - Assist with safety contingency plan, including documentation, communication, and testing
 - Coordinate and document safety meetings
 - Compile an end of job safety report including documentation of all safety information, incidents, hazards, inspections, and safety statistics
- Provide increased well-site security
- Record all people/services entering lease
- Help ensure only authorized personnel enter work site

Steeprock First Aid and Security Services employ professional safety & security coordinators. All of our employees will meet pre-employment standards by having experience in the industry and by having the communication skills required as an essential part of the team. Our Pre-employment benchmark also includes completion of courses and training that are required by the industry and regulators. Candidates are accepted into the hiring process where they are put through our interview and skills testing procedures to determine if they meet the criteria required to provide a high level of service. All Steeprock employees are put through an industry and company orientation. We strive for high company standards to ensure our company employs the qualified and professional people in the industry.

Steeprock can provide on- site trained security staff:

- Ensures only authorized individuals enter the work site
- Provide professional staff that ensures safety programs are being implemented, recorded and documented
- Exceed health and safety expectations
- Decrease liability and ensures due diligence
- Advance corporate image
- Promotes workplace professionalism and productivity

Mobile Treatment Centres

Steeprock First Aid and Security Service's industrial ambulances & mobile treatment centres meet or exceed all industry standards and provincial regulations. They are equipped with the highest standard of first aid supplies and equipment (based on the provincial hazard schedules for first aid supplies and equipment). The units are 2006 and newer model, 4x4 vehicles, that are off-road ready (tow hooks, heavy suspension, and winterized) and equipped with the appropriate communication equipment for each location. All Steeprock First Aid and Security Services vehicles are inspected before the start of each job by Steeprock technicians and inspected yearly by provincial registered inspectors to ensure that the vehicle is able to operate at a high level performance in the event of an emergency.

Communication & Security Equipment

Steeprock First Aid and Security Services ensure that their employees are equipped with the technology required to implement a basic safety program in a professional manner. For this reason all safety & security coordinators are trained and equipped with



communication systems (computers, cellular phone, satellite phones, two-way radio, printers, photocopier, scanner and internet) that allow the coordinator to produce professional documents and reports, track people entering and leaving the site, communicate with regulators and company officials, and develop end of job safety reports and statistics. Job-sites are equipped with security technology to ensure only authorized visitors and contractors are coming on site.

Steeprock staff has the following required certification:

- Valid B.C. and or/Alberta driver's license
- H2S
- WHMIS
- TDG
- CSTS courses
- Emergency response through ENFORM
- BST 1 & 2 JIBC certified
